JSA Standards and Specifications are private sector standards that can be developed using an agile standards development process to meet the needs of different types of organizations (private companies, associations, government agencies, academic societies, etc.) spanning across sectors.

JSA can provide a pay service to help organizations who want to develop a quality standard efficiently and quickly using its expertise as a SDO in standards development project management.

Flexible Private Sector Standard



Meeting a wide range of needs

JSA Standards and Specifications can be a host to areas that are not covered by the scope of the Industrial Standardization Act thus no JIS has been published. Individual organizations can be a solo proposer of a new standard.



Accelerated Development

The process used to develop JSA Standards and Specifications can make the accelerated development of the standard possible while ensuring a broad consensus. JSA Standards and Specifications can be published within three months at the earliest after the project launch.



Simple Procedure

Minimum three supporters are required to launch a JSA Standard development project. Two enquiry stages are held during the development, one at the project launch and the other at the completion of a draft standard, to make information regarding the proposed standard accessible to the public at an early stage and collect as much feedback as possible on the draft.

Sharing economy - Operation of an online platform - Specification (JSA-S1202:2019)

This JSA Standard was developed and published in conjunction with BSI PAS 202. ISO project to develop international standard based on this published JSA Standard is underway.

JSA Standards and Specifications Development Process



Application & Proposal

- Application form submitted to JSA by applicant organization
- Information collection on proposed subject matter by JSA
- JSA Standard development plan presented to applicant organization by JSA



Agreement Negotiation

- Negotiation on JSA Standard development plan as well as terms and conditions of development agreement between JSA and applicant organization takes place
- Proposed subject matter reviewed against JSA subject matter selection criteria for final approval



Agreement Conclusion

- JSA Standard development agreement signed prior to project launch
- Project Leader (PL) appointed by applicant organization
- Technical Program Manager (TPM) appointed by JSA
- JSA Standard development plan made available on JSA website



Draft Development

 Applicant organization organizes and runs JSA Standard development team as it leads project in cooperation with PL and TPM



Enquiry

- Draft JSA Standard made available on JSA website for public comment
- Comment period is 30 days



Finalized Draft Submission

- Finalized draft submitted to JSA for review
- Format adjustment by JSA
- Report on finalized draft prepared by TPM



Review

 Review Panel appointed by JSA evaluates TPM's report to ensure development of JSA Standard has been carried out properly



Publication

• Publication of JSA Standard approved by JSA after review by Review Panel is completed



Maintenance

- JSA and applicant organization share responsibility of handling inquires on published JSA Standard
- Review of published JSA Standard conducted by JSA within 3 years from its publication date in order to determine whether it should be confirmed as is or revised
