About criteria of training sessions for the purpose of training quality control managers

Introduction

In order to ensure the reliability of JIS mark products, the role of quality control manager is very important. JIS Certification Bodies Association makes the following 2 courses as standard for “the lectures of the subjects concerning the standardization and quality control” based on “the Ministerial Ordinance Concerning Certification of Conformity with Japanese Industrial Standards” in the item (v) - (b) - 2. of paragraph (1) of Article 2. Each accredited certification body shall be responsible for the final approval of quality control manager of Industrial standardization and Quality Control promotion.

1 Criteria for Training sessions for the purpose of training quality control managers

1.1 General Course

(1) Content

For the people responsible for the practice concerning the standardization and quality control,

- 1) Concentrated lecture required scopes concerning the general methods of the standardization and quality control intensively.
- 2) Lecture the necessary subjects and the area to quality control manager of the enterprises or organizations who implement JIS marking.
- 3) The tests and homework are given in order to check the degree of comprehension of the content of the lectures 1) and 2).

(2) Lecture hours

More than 60 hours total (an ordinary day's schedule 6 hours / day × 10 days)

(3) Subjects (People qualified to take the course)

There are no special qualifications.

(4) Lecture subjects

Criteria of the lecture subjects and the lecture hours are indicated below.

(5) Completion Test

The following tests will be given in order to check the extent of the lecture is well comprehended.

(6) Conditions for completion

We acknowledge that the participants have completed the course when all the conditions below are met.

1) Attendance rate

The attendance rate should be over 80 % and by the same person.

2) Completion test

Participants shall meet the following two conditions.

(a) The total score should be over 60 points. (Providing the total score is 100 points)

(b) The score of each subject should be over 40 % of the allotted scoring.

(7) The treatment for the participant who does not meet the conditions for the completion

The participants who cannot meet the completion condition indicated above (6), they should be treated as follows.

1) In case of the lack of the attendance

They will be treated as uncompleted. They have to retake the lectures in order to complete the course.

2) In case of getting the score below the desirable points.

The educating or training organ should give the necessary education again to the people concerned within 1 year after the final day of the received seminar. They are considered to have completed the course when they are believed to be enough prepared to become quality control manager. They must retake the course when their capability does not reach the standard and they are treated as uncompleted.

1.2 Short term Course

(1) Content

- 1) Lectures on the subjects necessary to become quality control manager such as Industrial standardization, Standardization within the firm, JIS Q 17025 are given.
- 2) The tests are given in order to check the degree of comprehension of the content of the lectures and the knowledge concerning standardization etc. on the final day of the course.

(2) Lecture hours

Over 10 hours total

(3) Subjects (People qualified to take the course)

The people who has the qualification; above 2nd grade of quality control licensing examination certified by Japan Quality Control Society

(4) Subjects

Criteria of the lecture subjects and the lecture hours are indicated below.

(5) Completion test

The completion test concerning the subjects below is given in order to confirm the comprehension of the content of the lectures.

(6) Conditions for completion

We acknowledge that the participants have completed the course when all the conditions below are met.

1) Attendance rate

The attendance rate should be 100 % and by the same person.

2) Completion test

Participants shall meet the following two conditions.

(a) The total score should be over 60 points. (Providing the total score is 100 points)

(b) The score of each subject should be over 40 % of the allotted scoring.

(7) The treatment for the participant who does not meet the conditions for the completion

The participants who cannot meet the completion condition indicated above (6), they should be treated as follows.

1) In case of the lack of the attendance

They will be treated as uncompleted. They have to retake the lectures in order to complete the course.

2) In case of getting the score below the desirable points.

The educating or training organ should give the necessary education again to the people concerned within 1 year after the final day of the received seminar. They are considered to have completed the course when they are believed to be enough prepared to become quality control manager. They must retake the course when their capability does not reach the standard and they are treated as uncompleted.

1.3 Special instruction

If anyone, who has completed "the lecture concerning the standardization and quality control" based on No.555 in "*the Ministerial Notification of Ministry of International Trade and Industry*" in 1997, also completes "Training sessions for the purpose of maintaining and enhancing quality control manager's capability", he/she can be considered having completed the lectures defined above 1 and 2.
