[Common 3] Concerning handling of long-time testing items

Question:

With regard to the long-time tests such as the hot-rolled internal pressure creep test of 8,760 hours for Crosslinked Polyethylene Pipes and the weather resistant test of 6,000 hours for Steel Wire Coated with Colored Plastics, can't we cope with such tests by utilizing the data of the past because the tests are the kind of type test at an early stage of design.

Interpretation:

Such tests shall be conducted in accordance with the provisions, even if it takes a long time to test.
