[Common 8] Concerning handling of remaining products which are affixing JIS Mark after the termination of the JIS certification agreement.

Question:

In case that a licensee desires to terminate the JIS certification agreement for its own reason, can the licensee continue to ship its remaining products affixing the JIS Mark, etc. after the termination of the agreement?

Interpretation:

Under any circumstances or for any reason whatsoever, no industrial and mineral products affixing the JIS Mark, etc. may be shipped to the market after the JIS certification agreement covering them has been terminated. It is vital that a licensee should apply for the termination of the JIS certification agreement after giving considerations toward the disposal of its inventory.

In addition, even if a licensee changes the accredited certification body A to B , its inventory affixing the JIS mark, etc. of A cannot be shipped after the termination of the JIS certification agreement with A.

It's no problem even if a licensee gets both certification of A and B in order to dispose of the inventories affixing the JIS Mark, etc. of A.
