[Common 6] Indication of JIS-Marks, etc. on industrial and mineral products at the Delivery Site where the product was assembled.

Question:

Regarding industrial and mineral products, which is a finished product by assembling several parts and those parts are shipped separately from separate plants or separate warehouses included in the scope of JIS certification, is it permitted to display JIS-mark, etc. at the delivery site where the product is assembled?

Interpretation:

- 1) The indication of the JIS Mark, etc. is basically the quality assurance at the time of shipping the product from a factory. Accordingly it is not permitted to indicate the JIS Mark, etc. on a finished product assembled at a site to which its parts had been separately delivered.
- 2) All components shall be shipped together (including the state of being packed up together) and shall be in the state that JIS mark etc. is indicated on them.

However, the main parts marked with the display of JIS Mark etc. and the specific parts shipped from other factory may be assembled as finished product at the delivery site.
