[Common 12] Display of "JIS licensee etc." on the packaging and encasement of the uncertified products by licensee.

Question:

Some our products has obtained JIS certification. Is it possible to indicate "JIS licensee" or a similar indication on the package or on the encasement of the product that have not obtained certification although JIS mark is not displayed on them?

Interpretation:

There is a risk that uncertified products packaged and encased may be misunderstood as if they were certified products. Therefore, the display is not accepted because it is in conflict with "the Ministerial Ordinance concerning all certifications of conformity with Japanese Industrial Standardization No. 15 Article No. 1 paragraph 4 item for industrial and mineral products and its Processing Technology."
